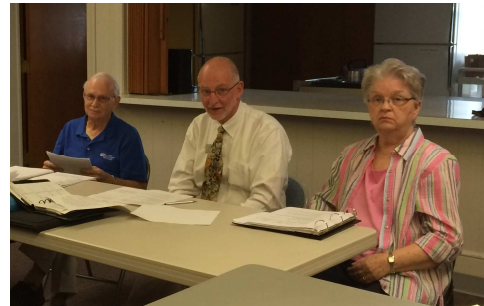
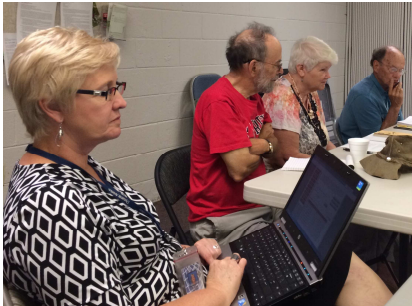

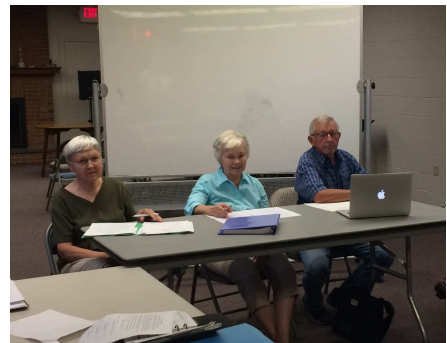

- A recently implemented EPA insulation specification will result in a 2-3 inch increase in size (height and diameter) for a given hot water heater. If you have a snug fit for a heater location, you may want to consider doing that change you have been thinking about. The cost for the modified

water heaters will also increase by \$200 to \$300, according to Mr. Good. Good Plumbing has a limited supply of the unmodified units on hand.

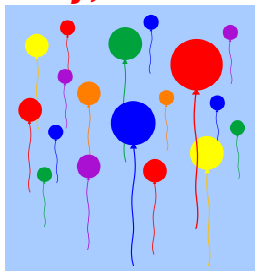
